

There are as many as 150 parts auditioned for every year. Auditions are held about 3 months before plays in April/May, June/July, October, December and February respectively.

In addition members take part in play readings, which may be informal in members' homes or rehearsed and staged. This is where new directors and actors can demonstrate their skills.

We do everything ourselves - costumes, props, lighting and set design and construction, publicity, front of house sales and ticket services. There is plenty to occupy everybody, in a very social atmosphere. There are occasional workshops on aspects of theatre.

There is absolutely no requirement to have previous skills when you join. Everyone can help out in some way on the working weekends, when show sets are painted and built, and the lighting rig installed.
